Dr. Lasater earned his medical degree from the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine in Oklahoma City, OK, in 1978, after receiving his Bachelor of Science degree from Southeastern Oklahoma State University in Durant, OK, in 1975. Attending the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences, he completed his Residency in General Surgery in 1980, Residency in Urology in 1982, and was Chief Resident Physician in Urology from 1982-1983.

Dr. Lasater served active duty in the United States Air Force Medical Corps, completing his service as a Major in 1987. While in the military, he was Director of Continuing Education at USAF-Tinker AFB in Oklahoma from 1983-1985 and Chief of Surgical Services at Tinker AFB from 1985-1986. Before joining Sentara Medical Group, Dr. Lasater practiced Urology at Craven Regional Medical Center in New Bern, NC, where he was a Past Chief of Medical Staff; and, most recently, a Trustee on the Medical Authority Board.
